Management of bone and joint deformities is becoming more challenging. This is due to higher expectations in treatment outcome, improving standards of living and increasing media coverage on medical advancements. At the same time, better understanding of bone healing process and development of new treatment modalities provides surgeons with means to correct nearly all components of deformity including discrepancies in limb length. With new implants and instrumentations, orthopaedic surgeons can restore anatomical alignment and achieve better functional outcome for patients with even severe deformities. This course is designed to expose orthopaedic and related clinical specialties to current treatment options, and provide them with hands-on exercises for the more complicated procedures.

Over the years, the orthopaedic department of University Malaya has developed workshop modules and deformity models on artificial bones to facilitate training for limb deformity correction.
