Re : Submission of articles to Malaysian orthopaedic Journal (MOJ)

The editorial board of Malaysian Orthopaedic Journal (MOJ) would like to invite doctors, health care providers and researchers who are involved in the field of orthopaedics and traumatology to submit scientific articles or case reports for the July issue of MOJ.

From 2009, abstracts of articles published in MOJ can be viewed in EMCare, a biomedical database hosted by Elsevier. We are also indexed by MyAIS, an indexing organization from Malaysia. Our most significant improvement in 2009 is in our online journal (allow free full text access / download). The number of viewers who logged into the MOJ homepage in 2010 has tripled as compared to 2008. We are now trying to get the journal indexed by Western Pacific Region Index Medicus (WPRIM), because this will allow our articles / abstracts to be listed in Index Medicus.

Please be reminded that the closing date for the next issue of MOJ would be **31st March 2010**. We are still receiving many manuscripts which were not prepared according to the journal guideline and they invariably resulted in delay in the reviewing and editing process. Please make use of the manuscript frame available on the website to prepare your work. In addition to scientific or clinical materials, the Board would also like to invite our readers to provide comments on the content of the articles, and suggestions on how we can improve the quality, presentation or effectiveness of this publication.
