I. Abstract submission

Deadline: January 15, 2012

CATEGORIES:

1. Basic Research in orthopaedic traumatology
2. Osteoporosis and fragility fractures
3. Minimal Invasive Surgery & Innovative Techniques
4. Infection and other complications after fracture fixation
5. Bony anatomy and implant development
6. Upper extremity injuries
7. Lower extremity injuries
8. Paediatric fractures
9. Pelvic and acetabular injuries and polytrauma management

Abstract content (Do not exceed 400 words) should include:

TITLE: Make the title brief and clearly indicate the nature of the study/procedure.

INTRODUCTION should clearly state the problem and the purpose of the study.

METHODS should provide a description of what was actually done.

RESULTS should contain the findings of the study.

DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSION should be based upon the findings and relate to the stated purpose of the study and existing knowledge.

II. Case Discussion submission

III. Presentation Format

1. Podium Presentation

Each Podium presentation will be approximately 5-7 minutes in length. Standard audiovisual equipment in the scientific session room includes an LCD projector and Windows Computer. Personal laptops cannot be used for presentations.

2. Poster Presentation

Posters will be displayed at designated poster area during meeting.

Please provide your name and valid email address while submission. The final decision of acceptance will be announced by the end of February 2012.
